The NZCEL (L4) will equip learners with English language proficiency and the academic skills in listening, speaking, reading and writing to enable them to successfully enter a diploma or bachelor degree level programme of study without having to complete IELTS.

NZCEL (L4) is the pathway to undergraduate qualifications and NZCEL (L5). A very high level of commitment is required for this programme.

### Student Work Rights

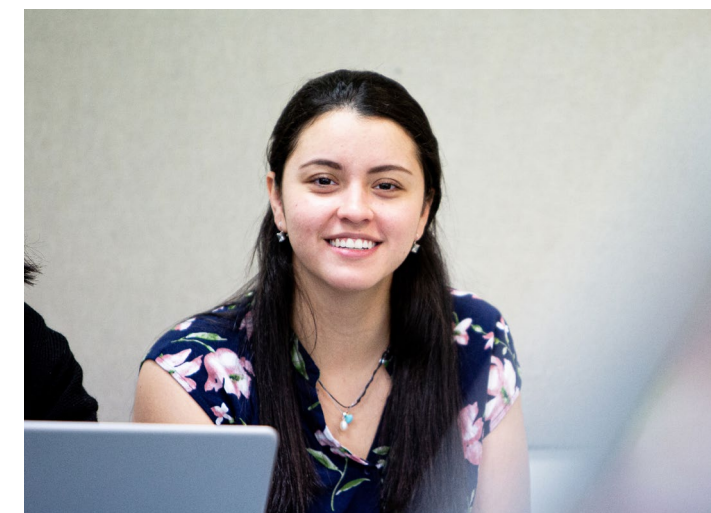

## Group Options

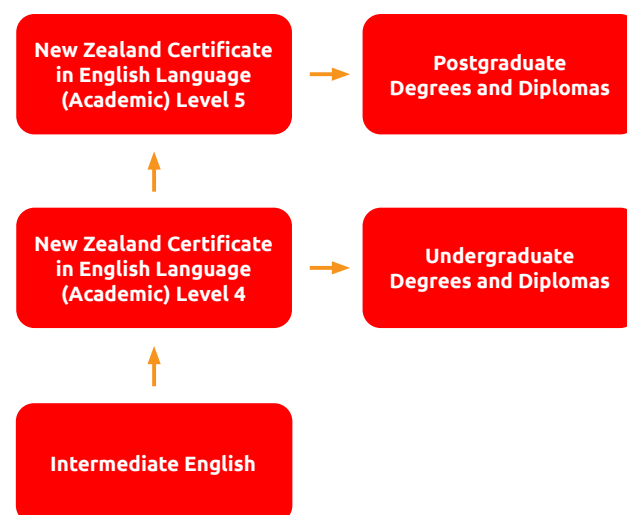
The ELC at AIS has the following options for groups (subject to minimum numbers):
